### **Dolman Theatre Festival**

It is with great excitement that we announce St. Joseph's R.C. Primary School is performing our end of year arts festival. The festival will be held on Monday 23rd June at the Dolman Theatre, Kingsway, Newport.

Due to a tight rehearsal schedule, on this day, please bring the children to school between 8am and 8.30am. We will then leave school promptly to walk to the Dolman Theatre for a dress rehearsal. All children will need to be in school by 8.30am, as we will be leaving early to walk to the theatre.

**Children who normally attend school Breakfast Club will still be able to attend, the other children will make their way down to the classroom when you drop them off.**

Children will need a packed lunch and water - please, no glass bottles or fizzy drinks. Also, please avoid "messy" foods such as yogurts as we have limited facilities at the theatre.

If you wish for your child to have a packed lunch from the canteen, please inform the school by 12 noon on Thursday 19th June 2025.

Your class teacher will let you know what your child will need to wear, if there are any changes.

Parents are invited to watch the festival which starts at 1pm. Doors will open at 12.30pm. The performance is anticipated to finish at approximately 3.20pm.

The theatre has a limited seating capacity and therefore we must limit tickets to three per family. Tickets cost £3 each and will be available to purchase via ParentPay. Monies raised will be shared between the Dolman Theatre and the Friends of St. Joseph's. Tickets will be available to purchase on a first come, first served basis until Wednesday 18th June.

At the end of the performance, children will be dismissed by their teacher from the theatre. Foundation Phase classes (Rec, Y1, Y2) will be dismissed a class at a time, in the main foyer at the theatre. Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 will be dismissed, a class at a time, from the stage door.

**All children will need to be picked up from the Dolman Theatre on this day. There will be no dismissal from school.** We hope you are as excited as we are for this amazing opportunity! If you have any questions, please contact the school office.
